

OUR MISSION

Grace Prison Ministries Mission Statement in fulfilling the twofold mission of the "Great Commission" (Matthew 28:19-20) is as follows:

- 1. **EVANGELISM** This includes winning the unsaved that are incarcerated but not limited to the saving knowledge of Jesus Christ through:
- a) The presentation of the simple gospel message of faith alone in Christ alone for salvation to those incarcerated and abroad.
- b) We will make the gospel as clear as possible, relying on the convicting ministry of the Holy Spirit, and leaving the decision to believe or reject to the individual.
- c) We will use no gimmicks to win people to Christ.
- 2. **EDIFICATION** Bring to spiritual maturity those who have put their faith in Jesus Christ for salvation through teaching them the word of God so that they too can function as part of the body of Christ in further evangelism and edification. We do this in the following manner:
 - a) We provide Bibles as God provides to those who don't have one.
 - b) We teach sound doctrine in the prisons, in a local church setting, and through prison conferences.
 - c) We provide resources like Biblical books, recorded and written lessons.
 - d) We direct the believer to a local church upon release from prison.

In conjunction with these two primary missions, we also have the following objectives:

EQUIPPING - Start Bible Institutes in prisons providing resources for training, so the serious students of the Word of God can be trained for local church service and missionary work abroad especially in the prisons.

Assisting the needy as God provides and directs us - This may include but is not limited to:

- a) Provision of food
- b) Provision of clothing



Biblical Women - Hood

A Christian woman today faces a more difficult task living her life according to biblical teaching than at any other time in history. Those influences are so dominant that even the Christian woman often forms her attitudes and opinions from human sources rather than basing them on God's word. Furthermore there is an even wider variance in the level of understanding of and commitment to biblical womanhood among Christian women today.

God created the woman and "designed" her for a specific purpose. God designed the woman for the man's benefit. There is no indication anywhere in scripture that a married woman is to have a purpose of her own apart from her husband. The man and woman were created to act as a couple. This helps to explain the mystery of marriage, the joining of the two parts into one flesh. God's purpose in forming the woman was to provide for man a mate corresponding to him. God uses her abilities to aid and complement her husband's role and calling in life. A woman has important work to do in order to fulfill her God given purpose. She should use her intelligence, talents, and abilities in such a way that her efforts give support and encouragement to her man. This could range from providing a stable, comfortable home to working in her husband's business or giving moral support for his ministry. In other words she helps her husband she is actually living out her trust in God.

God ordained authority structure for marriage it reveals that the husband is the head of the family and that wives do not have equal authority in marriage. Every Christian wife answers directly to God for obeying his word and regarding

submission to her husband's authority. Christian marriage is desired to portray to the world an image of the bind between believers and Christ. The role in marriage pictures the spiritual authority of Christ and of the believers' submissive. bond, and oneness with Christ. Presenting a Christ like image in marriage should be the goal of every Christian couple.

The Biblical wife is privileged to play a role in the interlinking spiritual significance of her helpmate's position and Christ's submission to God the father. A biblical wife submits to her husband because she desires to live according to God's will.

A biblical woman is a woman that respect her husband no matter if he is wrong or right. She is her husband's helper. She is to let her husband have all the authority. She is to support her husband's role as a protector. A biblical women in marriage is to honor her husband in everything he does and take care of their children. She is to stay in God's word and teach her children, and live a godly life. She should stay spiritually connected to God.

What Does It Mean To Be A Saint?

Some have taken the word "Saint" to mean that you are a saint because you are a religious person. Someone who performs good deed, and makes a moral effort to perform that which is good. Biblically a person is a Saint because of his position in Christ, and his faith in the finish work of Jesus Christ on the cross.

In 1 Cor. 1:2; 2 Cor. 1:1, Rom. 1:1; and Ephesians 1:1, Paul addresses his recipients as Saints. The word translated saints is the Greek noun hagios in the plural form meaning "holy, sacred". The word hagios in the plural form can be rendered "holy ones". Saints are God's holy ones. In order for a person to be holy they must be set apart from sin, and this is what God did at the moment a believer put his faith in Jesus Christ for salvation.

Saints are saints because of their position in Christ. When Paul referred to believers as saints in Rom. 8:27 and Rom. 12:13 he was declaring that the believers were God's holy ones, consecrated to God for His service.

Believers are saints because they are in a right relationship with Him who is the "Holy One".

- God the Father is said to be the "Holy One" (1 John 2:20)
- Jesus Christ is said to be "the Holy and righteous one" (Acts 3:14)
- The Holy Spirit is said to be Holy (Matt. 28:19; 1 Cor. 6:19)

Believers are called saints which mean holy ones (1 Thess. 3:13; 2 Thess. 1:10). They are not saints in the sense that they are religious people, but because of their new relationship with God through Christ.

The moment a person trusts in Christ as His savior, he is placed in union with Christ who is holy and righteous. Therefore believers share in this holiness and righteousness by being in Him. (2 Cor. 5:21).

Believers' own efforts, and good deeds are not what makes him a saint but the work of Jesus Christ on the cross. Scripture teaches that every believer receives the righteousness of God by faith (Rom. 3:22) and that believers are made the righteousness of God in Him. So, by faith believers have been set-apart from sin, given the righteousness of God by faith, and placed in a new position in Christ.

Believers are set apart unto God for His service, and use. Saints in the church age are God's possession as Israel was in the Old Testament (Ex. 19:6), chosen by God and appointed to his service. Believers are to live out their new position in Christ by living a godly life in the world.

Positionally all believers are saints, and in practice only a few act like saints. When we meet four spiritual conditions we begin to act like saints:

- 1. **Grieve not the Holy Spirit**of God (Ephesians 4:30)
 How do we not grieve the Holy
 Spirit? When we sin which is
 disobedience we grieve the Holy
 Spirit, and give control of our lives
 to our sin-natures. So we are not
 to have un-confessed sins in our
 life. Sin grieves the indwelling
 Holy Spirit and hinders his work in
 our lives. When we sin we only
 need to acknowledge our wrong
 to God. (Psalm 32:5; 1 John 1:9)
- 2. Quench not the Holy Spirit (1 Thess. 5:19)
 How do we not quench the Holy Spirit? We are to yield to the will of God as he reveals His will in His word. (Rom. 6: 11-14; Rom. 12:1-2)
- 3. Walk by the Spirit (Gal. 5:16)
 We are to live in constant
 dependence on God the Holy
 Spirit to do what we cannot do in
 our own power and strength.

Conclusion: Saints are to act like saints and this is only possible as we allow the Holy Spirit to influence our lives by habitually obeying the word of God.

Dying to Self

A wealthy university graduate chose to live frugally in a single room, cooking his own meals. As a result he was able to give two million dollars to foreign missions. In explanation of his choice he wrote these words: "Gladly would I make the floor my bed, a box my chair, and another box my table, rather than men should perish for want of knowledge of Christ." I am not suggesting that all Christians are called upon to forfeit the normal comforts of life; only, when God calls them to a life of sacrifice, they be willing to leave all and follow Him.

- 1. Grace Prison Ministries will seek to honorably and faithfully execute the stewardship of all provided resources to the glory of God.
- 2. Grace Prison Ministries will maintain its 501(c)(3) tax status with the Department of Treasury, Internal Revenue Service(IRS), assuring full deductibility of gifts which meet IRS Requirements.
- 3. Grace Prison Ministries will use gifts for the purposes designated by donors. When undesignated, gifts will be used for current Grace Prison Ministries priorities.
- 4. Grace Prison Ministries will promptly issue receipts for every donation, with necessary information to satisfy all IRS requirements.
- 5. Grace Prison Ministries will not solicit for funding but will share our ministry objectives with interested organizations or individuals and leave the decision to support us to God and the individual or entity
- 6. Grace Prison Ministries will not release, sell or otherwise distribute mailing lists to any organization, and will maintain confidentiality of all donor records to the greatest legal extent.
- 7. Grace Prison Ministries will make quarterly financial statements available to donors upon request, and will answer all inquiries from donors promptly.
- 8. Grace Prison Ministries expenditure budgets and salaries will be approved by its Board of Governors.

Grace Prison Ministries At-A-Glance

Grace Prison Ministries Inc. is a Christian, graceoriented, nonprofit organization incorporated in Tennessee which focuses on changing the lives of prisoners and their families through evangelism and sound Bible teaching.

GPM travels to jails, prisons, and youth detention centers throughout the United States; evangelizing individuals with the message of Jesus Christ at four to five institutions per month. This activity is important because the message of Jesus Christ brings hope, forgiveness, and change to those incarcerated. This way, those incarcerated can become law-abiding citizens and good role models in our society. Upon our visits we provide Bibles for those in need of Bibles. In conjunction with the above activities GPM has the following ministries which are designed to bring glory to Jesus Christ and edification to believers:

Operation Impact Lives

Operation Impact Lives is a group of believers partnering to impact the lives of prisoners. O.I.L. is comprised of pastors, evangelists, and church leaders. Periodically, conferences are held in prisons, jails and youth detention centers where pastors, evangelists and passionate believers join together to fulfill the great commission (presenting the Gospel and equipping the saints). We take the gospel, sound Bible teaching, and resources to them which gives prisoners hope, purpose, and a new way of thinking.

Discipleship through Mail

The Discipleship through Mail outreach is designed to equip new believers in the basic fundamental doctrines for living the normal Christian life. Bible lessons and resources are mailed to individual students in various prisons, jails, and youth detention centers, providing them an opportunity to learn and grow at their own pace. These lessons are reviewed and then mailed back to the students with comments that will provide a greater understanding of Bible truths. Upon completion of the basics, students are rewarded with a study Bible, which is hard for some to get in prison.
